Art, reading, music, table activities, center play, and active play are a part of every day. We also work on personal hygiene, building personal responsibility, monthly spiritual emphasis topics taught through Bible stories and age appropriate devotionals, developing good character traits, cooperation, self- esteem and self -help skills. Children attend music every day, playroom once a week, and chapel once a month.
