Faith Connections is a four-week study series offered to members and guests of our Pollard community to revitalize and discover church membership. The goal is to discover the ways that God makes our faith journey a shared experience, and to discover or renew your connection to the Pollard faith community and ministry. The study is conducted in four sessions over a period of four weeks. Over the course of study, participants look at our Christian heritage and commitments, our Methodist heritage and commitments, and our Pollard heritage and commitments. Whether you are a guest exploring Pollard membership or a Pollard member revitalizing your connection, please join us!

Session One — *Our Christian Heritage and Beliefs*

Our first connection in faith is to the Christian community we know as “The Body of Christ”. This session will examine the core Christian beliefs we share with others who are Christian. Since Pentecost the church has been at work establishing the basic beliefs of the Christian people and seeking to make them a part of the Christian tradition and experience. What must a Christian agree to in order to be Christian?

Session Two — *The People Called Methodists*

Learn about the formation and history of the Methodist people. Follow the beginnings of the Wesley family, and the methods of ministry that enabled a move from England to the American Colonies, and eventually to Texas. What historical occasions shaped their movement and beliefs? What is a “shouting Methodist?” Catch the spirit and share the story!

Session Three — *Uniquely Methodist*

Learn about the current structure and processes of the United Methodist Church. Explore the current beliefs and social responses of the United Methodist Church. Where is the authority, and how is that determined? What is the Book of Discipline for? What must one agree to in order to be a Methodist?

Session Four — *The Pollard Family of Faith*

Why Pollard? What’s the story of the Pollard church family? Hear the story, learn what began as their vision and now becomes our vision today. Look at the Pollard Mission Statement, and discover the faithful commitment of our church family. What do I need to do in order to join the Pollard Church Family?
